

Bridge-Training.com - practise Bidding and Declarer Play

Bid the Hand

- White circle on the table shows whose turn it is to bid or play
- Click on the bids in the bidding box when it is your turn to bid
- Bids that are unavailable to you (because they are lower than the last made bid) will be greyed out on the bidding box
- If you don't make the best bid, the program will give you another go. If you don't make the recommended bid a second time, the program will automatically make the suggested bid. *(If nothing is happening you may need to Pass).*
- If available, explanations of the correct bids will be provided for Opener and Responder bids. They flash up temporarily, but can be viewed again by hovering your mouse above the bids made in the "Auction" box immediately above the table.

The Play

- The Defenders make a lead and play to trick one starts. **You will always be Declarer (South).** *(Occasionally the first trick(s) is played automatically).*
- If Opponents win a trick you may need to click cursor on the screen to move game forward. May need to click twice on a card to select it.



- **UNDO** - brings up a choice of three buttons to "Rewind" to the start of the Auction, **UNDO** the last trick played or "Fast Forward to the end of Play". Also allows you to "claim"



- Shows the contract details and last played trick.
- The number of tricks won by N/S & E/W are shown in the top LH corner



Options once played

- You can **Play again, Display deal** (see all 4 hands) or go to **Game Review** (give hints & tips on how to bid & play the hand) - just click on screen after the last card has been played.
